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# Direct Certification 7 CFR 245.6(b)

A process conducted by the States and by local educational agencies (LEAs) to certify eligible children for free and reduced price meals without the need for household applications.

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# **Direct Certification Overview**



# Direct Certification 7 CFR 245.6(b)

If a household submits a household application for directly certified children, the direct certification eligibility determination will take precedence, *only if* the benefit status resulted in *FREE Exact Match - Certified*.



The household always receives the better of the benefit.





#### Electronic Data Matching 7 CFR 245.6(b)(2)

The Office for Food and Nutrition Programs electronically matches data of direct certification with:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Transitional Assistance for Families with Dependent Children (TAFDC)
- Department of Children and Families (DCF) Foster Child(ren) certification
- · Certain categories of Medicaid

# Frequency of Direct Certification

7 CFR 245.6(b)(3) 7 CFR 245.6(b)(4) At or around the beginning of the school year (i.e., July 1)

Three months after the beginning of the school year; and

Six months after the beginning of the school year.

DESE encourages LEA's to conduct direct certification more frequently to obtain information about newly enrolled children or children who may be newly certified for that program 's benefits.





# **Direct Certification Documentation**

7 CFR 245.6(b)(5), 7 CFR 245.6(b)(6), 7 CFR 245.6(b)(7), 7 CFR 245.6(b)(10)



Point of Sale (POS) systems must be able to accept both FREE & REDUCED Exact Match status

Work with the POS vendor to include the additional Direct Certification status

# **Direct Certification Documentation**

7 CFR 245.6(b)(5), 7 CFR 245.6(b)(6), 7 CFR 245.6(b)(7), 7 CFR 245.6(b)(10) Extension of Eligibility

If any child is identified as a member of a household receiving assistance under SNAP or TANF, all children in the family, as defined in 7 CFR 245.2, shall be categorically eligible for free meals or (reduced price meals).

This applies to children identified through direct certification or through a free and reduced price application.





# Direct Certification Documentation

7 CFR 245.6(b)(5), 7 CFR 245.6(b)(6), 7 CFR 245.6(b)(7), 7 CFR 245.6(b)(10) **Notification to Families** 

LEA's are not required to provide application materials to FREE Exact Match Certified.

However, SFA's are encouraged to provide & make available applications to all households.

Families must be informed of the free and reduced price meal benefits

#### **Confidentiality**

7 CFR 245.6(b)(9)

Confidential nature of direct certification information.


- Information about children or their households obtained through the direct certification process must be kept confidential and is subject to the limitations on disclosure of information in section 9 of the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act, 42 U.S.C. 1758.
- Information that a household is receiving benefits from SNAP, FDPIR or TANF or
  that a child is participating in another program which makes children categorically
  eligible for free school meals or free milk must be used solely for the purposes of
  direct certification for determining children's eligibility for free school meals or free
  milk and as otherwise permitted under 7 CFR 245.6(f).


